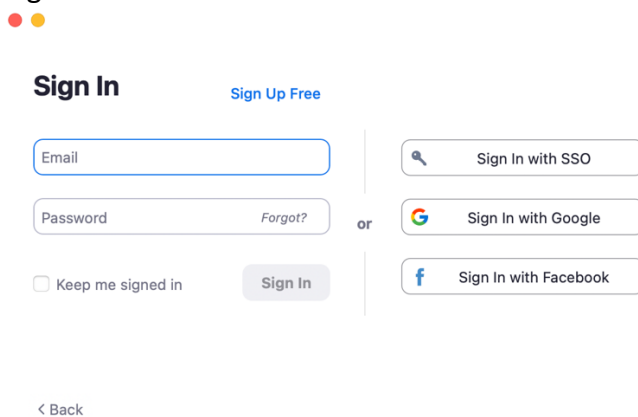


Getting Started with Zoom

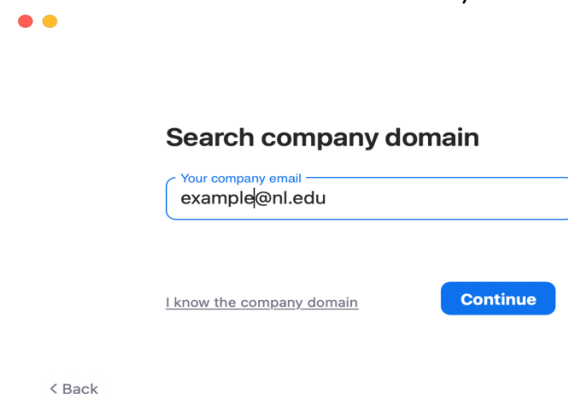
This document will show you how to access your NLU zoom account

1. First you will need to open your Zoom application.
 - If you do not already have it installed to your machine, go to zoom.us/download and download “Zoom Client for Meetings”. Follow the install instructions
2. Now that you have your Zoom application open, click on “Sign In”. You will then get a sign in window.
