

FP106 - Ranking of Academic Administrators
Approvals: Faculty Senate, President, Board of Trustees
Effective: June 15, 2023

To qualify for a particular faculty rank for a coterminous title, the administrator must meet the criteria for the particular rank as outlined in FP104. The coterminous title can be requested by the administrator upon appointment or hire into the administrative position or requested at any time by a Dean or Provost.

Such administrators are granted faculty title but not appointment or tenure.

Termination of the administrative appointment results in termination of the coterminous faculty title. Upon changing administrative positions while at NLU, the individual needs to re-request a coterminous faculty title.

Titles are subject to approval by the Provost. Administrators with faculty title do not carry a teaching load and are not voting members of the faculty association, college meetings, senate, or college committees. They are not eligible for rank promotion, do not participate in faculty performance evaluations, and are not considered for full-time faculty positions except by participation in a normal search process for an authorized vacancy.
