Her story is grounded in Writing and Rhetoric research with a particular emphasis on how grading practices impact student learning. By affirming the important connections between language and identity, she will share her experiences with alternative grading systems that invite students to unapologetically include their voices in academic spaces. Through her own story, Dr. Gonzales Howell weaves together the ways in which assessment and teaching values influence student engagement and motivation.
