

National Louis University Joins the Metropolitan Chicago Tutoring Corps. Earn up to \$700 per week during the 2023-24 School Year! We need tutors during Winter quarter!

Dear National Louis University Students,

Thanks to a grant from A Better Chicago, Roosevelt University created the Metropolitan Chicago Tutoring Corps (MCTC) in collaboration with Chicago Public Schools (CPS). Corps members provide paid, high-dosage tutoring during the school day in reading and literacy to kindergarten through fifth grade students in select CPS schools during the 2023 – 24 school year.

The MCTC is a focused effort to address the needs of Chicago students and prepare them for success as schools emerge from the COVID-19 pandemic.

All corps members will be employed by CPS and paid for their tutoring during the school day. CPS will pay corps members \$20-22 an hour, if you're willing to tutor for 20-32 hours per week. That's \$400-\$700 a week!

MCTC is open to all National Louis University undergraduate and graduate students! Teacher candidates enrolled in elementary education are especially encouraged to apply. All who want to help make a positive difference in the lives of our future leaders are welcome.

Acceptance into the MCTC will provide National Louis University students with other important benefits:

- Specialized support and training during the Fall and Spring semesters for the tutoring work to be completed.
- Up to \$2,000 to cover expenses related to childcare and transportation.
