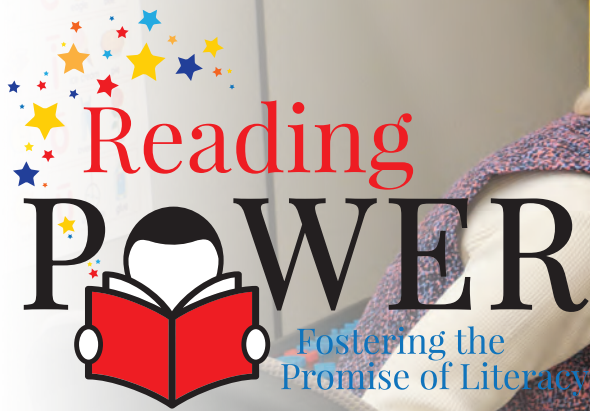




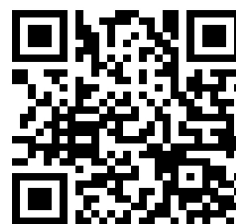
Learn more about how to become a tutor at Reading Power, inc.!
