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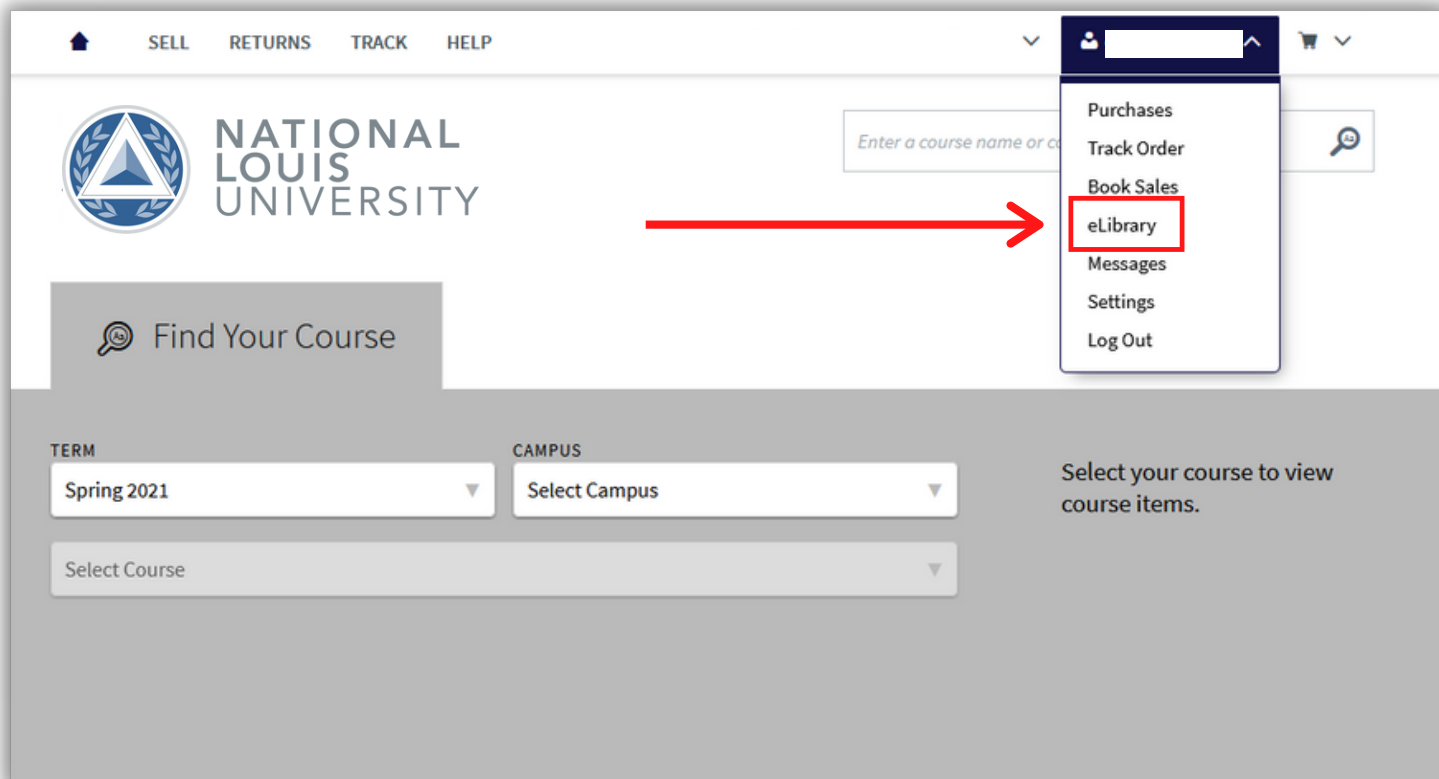

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COURSEWARE: For materials from publishers like McGraw Hill, Cengage, or Pearson, the eLibrary lists links to the platform as well as unique access codes. *While most courseware access is emailed, some is physically mailed, depending on the publisher. Courseware access that is mailed will not appear in the eLibrary, but tracking information will be listed under your "Purchases" page.
